If you choose, you can make your own flight arrangements. You will be responsible for your transportation from the airport to Port of Civitavecchia, Italy.



HOW TO TRAVEL TO CRUISE PORT FROM ROME

Port of Civitavecchia, Italy



- Royal Caribbean offers a shuttle to and from Rome to Port of Civitavecchia, Italy for an extra cost. Call for cost of shuttle.
- Ride the train cost 12.50 Euros one way. You will take a taxi to the train station travel to Civitavecchia, Italy (cheapest way) It is a 5-10 walk to the train station.
- Take a taxi the cost is around 140 (Euros)
- You will also need transportation to return to the airport in Rome





• The CFN Tour will begin on June 9 boarding the Odyssey of the Seas cruise ship and ends when you depart the ship in Civitavecchia, Italy. Our team will make sure you have directions for the shuttle, train or taxi. Please arrive in Civitavecchia on June 8.

PORTS OF CALL - SANTORINI, GREECE



- **Santorini** is located in the Aegean Sea about 124 miles south-east of Greece. Santorini is small, and included in the volcanic islands of the Aegean Sea. Many people believe that Santorini is the lost island of Atlantis.
- Visit the Archaeological Museum of Thera, which was built in 1960 by the Ministry of Public works. This was built to replace older museums that was hit by an earthquake in 1956. The museum holds sculptures, vases, and inscriptions dated back to the Roman period.



PORTS OF CALL - MYKONOS, GREECE

Mykonos is an island of Greece. It is one of the Cyclades, a group of islands of the Aegean Sea. There are just about 6,200 residents. The chief town is Mykonos, also known as Hora, on the west coast.



PORTS OF CALL - EPHESUS (KUSADASI), TURKEY

• **Kusadasi** is a town on the Aegean coast of Turkey, near Ephesus. It is really popular as a tourist destination, both for its many beaches, and as the port for cruise ship passengers heading to Ephesus. It was known as New Ephesus, Scala Nuova, and Kush Adasi at the beginning of the 20th century.

Just next to the old harbor is a small island that has a rock with the shape of a bird's head. Near to Kusadasi, there is a national park full of beautiful beaches. Also, several aqua-parks are located near the town.

"THE SEAPASS" PROGRAM

The SeaPass is an on board expense account. It is the cashless system used for all purchases and services. The SeaPass cards will be in your stateroom waiting for you. The account may be set-up with either a credit card or as a cash account.

When you receive your SeaPass card, it will have an icon confirming your purchase of "The Key". If you don't see it, ask your Statroom attendant or go to the Guest Services to apple the icon.

VOOM Internet

What is VOOM and how much does it cost?

VOOM is the name of Royal Caribbean high-speed internet service, the fastest internet at sea. With the installation of VOOM, you are no longer confined to a specific location on the ship to have connectivity. There are wired (iCafes) and Internet stations available onboard.

If **high-speed Internet access is important** for you and your family, VOOM Surf & Stream will be the key to keeping everyone happy. And, it is included in the price of "The Key" as follows: one online package per paying guest on one device. This inclusion also offers us the opportunity to do a bit of price comparison with some simple math.

Every passenger can buy access to WiFi. It is satellite-based and works throughout the ship. However, if you check the cost – which is calculated by the number of devices and which package - the price of just buying VOOM as a stand-alone option is often close to the price of the entire Key package per day. The cost of VOOM varies by the number of devices and the service package purchased. We recommend that guests purchase VOOM pre-cruise to enjoy the biggest discount from onboard prices. Guests who have a reservation with payment may also contact 1-800-398-9819 for Pre-Cruise Planning Assistance. For example, if VOOM by itself is around \$20/per day (for one device for one person) and "The Key" is \$25/per day (for the same) and you definitely need WiFi, then you are getting all the other Key perks for only \$5/day in our example. With that in mind, if WiFi is the main and only reason for interest in this program, it would be more economical to buy one of the singly priced Internet option packages. But, (and this is an important one!) you would have to share a device throughout the cruise. Probably not a terrific idea when traveling with children.
